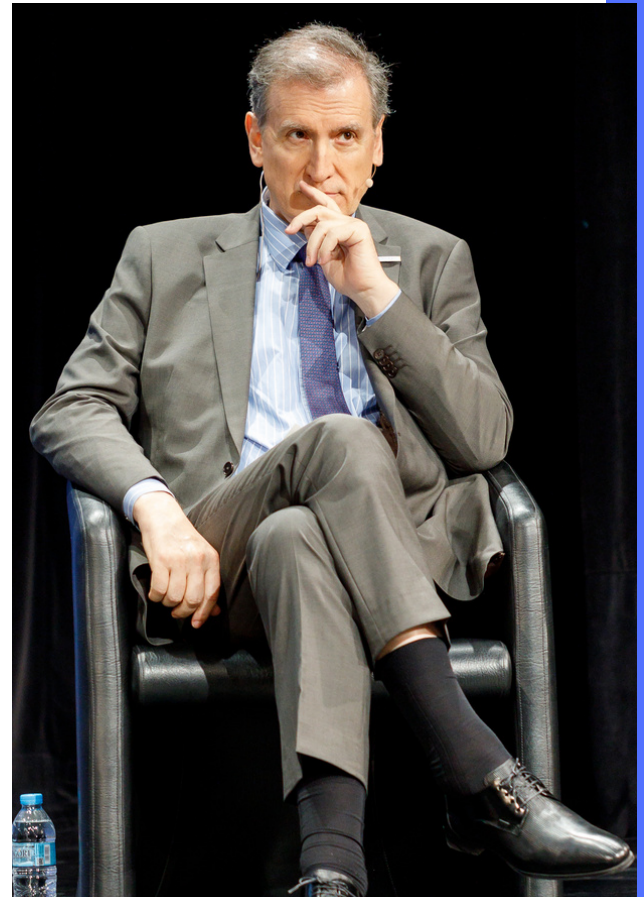

How young participants can best prepare themselves and succeed, III. Steps and processes involved in entering or advancing in their chosen field, IV. Possible partnerships and collaborations with relevant organizations, V. Networking opportunities to expand professional connections, etc.

For the Speed Mentoring event on the 20th of July, which will last 1 hour, participants-mentees can choose to join:

- a group session (40 minutes) and an individual session (20 minutes) or,
- three individual sessions, with each session lasting for 20 minutes.

Groups' Session: Participants will join a group discussion among the four groups listed below with 3 to 6 Mentors and engage in an open conversation about the session's topic

Individuals' Sessions: Participants will have the opportunity to have one-on-one sessions with individual Mentors, and ask questions related to the Mentor's area of expertise.
